

or comical?*



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


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Speed of Thought

Will I force any decisions on individuals to '*add another string to that bow*'



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Drills or Games?

Last night's debate among tutors

From 'little ball work' to 'lots of ball work'

From 'drills' to 'decision-making' [i.e. games]

From 'on the ball' to 'off the ball'

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In terms of technical issues a few arise. While there has been a marked development in the players' stick and ball work one area of possible concern is emerging. When playing strong opposition in 15 a side games it is clear that the hurlers who have played mainly, or only Go Games, lack a certain positional awareness and have difficulty with the shape of the game.
